What's at Stake

Across the criminal legal system, impacted individuals face disproportionate adverse outcomes, such as not being able to make bail, experiencing longer pretrial incarceration, and experiencing severe disciplinary issues in jail or prison.

Cross-system collaboration can improve outcomes and promote recovery. Bringing systems together to work on these complex issues takes training and careful preparation.



Our Solution

The 2-day **Sequential Intercept Model Facilitator Training** teaches participants how to deliver a Sequential Intercept Model (SIM) Mapping Workshop in their communities. The SIM Mapping Workshop encourages collaboration between the behavioral health and criminal legal systems, as well as other supporting services.

Facilitator training participants learn how to guide local planning partners through the SIM Mapping Workshop by reviewing the Workshop model, design, and tools; receiving facilitation training; and working through practice SIM Mapping Workshop sessions.



Our Model

The **Sequential Intercept Model Facilitator Training** is a 2-day event designed to teach participants how to deliver the Sequential Intercept Model Mapping Workshop in their communities. The **Sequential Intercept Model** covers six intercepts. Each highlights a key part of the criminal legal process:

- Community services
- Law enforcement
- Initial detention and initial court hearings
- Jails and courts
- Reentry
- Community corrections



Participants

The participants involved in the **Sequential Intercept Model Facilitator Training** include the following:

- Criminal legal system professionals, including law enforcement, pretrial services, courts, jails, and community corrections professionals
- Behavioral health professionals
- People with lived experience in the behavioral health and criminal legal systems, family members, and advocates
- Social services professionals
- State and/or regional representatives
